Subject: Proposed Field Trip Stops

The four main stops are at points along the creek where it crosses faults of the Balcones Fault Zone as they are shown on the BSEACD geologic map. The proposed stops are shown as yellow dots on a topographic base in Attachment A.

As time permits, we can also walk the creek bed and examine outcrops either side of the creek.
