Subject: Geologic Mapping East of the Blanco River in the Mountain City Quadrangle

An area that has not yet been mapped (actually, remapped, from my 1976 dissertation) in our Mountain City Quadrangle Geologic Mapping Project is the area east of the Blanco River below its sharp bend to the southeast. During the first half of July, considerable progress has been made in completing the mapping of this area. This memo is an update of the one that I sent on July 12.

An air photo showing the added mapping is in Attachment 1. Significant features observed in the field are shown in Attachments 2 to 7. The approximate locations of the features are shown in Attachment 1.

- 7. "Hog Wallow" in Del Rio Clay

View is to the southwest. The grassy area is underlain by the Del Rio clay, whereas the prickly pear cactus and oak trees are underlain by the Edwards.
